Comments:	The caller gave an incorrect address; she resides at house no. 38 De la Rey Street, Observatory, when I called her to meet, as I arrived at her place. She invited me to her house and walked me to the dog that was ill. At the time of my arrival, the dog was appeared to be lifeless, discharging irregular (smelly) liquids consistent with those of a parvovirus patient from both ends (oral and anal discharge) laying down on his left flank. "Rider" was pronounced dead after confirming a cold body temperature and no pulse. The body was collected from the yard and taken to the SPCA for proper disposal. They have another 9-month-old dog on the property, which I advised them to take to the vet as soon as possible and keep her isolated for being exposed to the virus. Mrs Maketha promised to do so the next day. She, on the other hand, did not show any symptoms. She said transport was not available off to work with her husband but I advised her to make other means of transporting her dogs in such cases, but proof of prior treatment of the dog was presented to me. I drew a 5ml of pre-diluted F10 SC into their 750ml empty spray bottle to make a disinfecting solution to use on solid surfaces (concrete + pavement), but I still informed her that the rest of the yard remains contaminated. I'll keep up with the remaining dog in 2 days.
