General Report Comments: I met the owner upon arrival, who invited me inside. He owns a ±8-year-old, tan Boerboel dog named "Bokkie". The dog was enclosed on the covered porch of approximately 3,73 m². A green X-Large igloo dog kennel and a bucket of potable water were provided. The owner stated that the reason for keeping the dog on the porch was for the safety of his tenants(but familiar with them) and visiting associates, as he's running his businesses from home, but he gets freed to the whole yard at night as per the reported claims. The owner revealed that he's had incidents of the dog attacking some of his visitors. The dog's living place appeared to be kept clean and hygienic. "Bokkie" appeared to be in acceptable shape, and food (Bobtail™) was in supply. I advised Mr Hadebe to partition the yard (also in my previous visit) in a manner that will provide sufficient running space and he then stated that he did take my advice and had already gotten material since but had to pause due to fund constraints is still working on rearranging his yard to construct a running camp for the dog. He admitted that "Bokkie" was also getting old and would have to let him go soon, which is why he did not fully commit to the construction of the camp. I advised him to consider surrendering the dog, and he said he would in case of ill-health caused by age, as he's obviously keeping the dog to deter intruders and having found a replacement for "Bokkie". There were no offences in respect of animals found. The owner was educated
