General Report Comments: I was tended by the house help, who called out her boss. The lady of the house came and opened the door for me to investigate claims made about their dogs. She took me through her house, where she was keeping 8 of her Husky dogs, with males separated from their female counterparts. The 2 younger (both one-year-old) females, named "Dusty" and "Aurora", were kept in the front porch along with their mother (a 4-year-old) female, "Scarlet". They were kept in the front yard while their room upstairs was being cleaned by the gardener. The males(5) in the backyard were free-roaming the whole yard with a solidly built wooden narrow structure as their shelter. All the dogs appeared to be in acceptable physical condition. Dog food was available in at least 3 x 40kg Montego: Monty&Me bags and potable water. Mrs Kaye revealed to me that one of the females was on heat; no wonder the males keep making noise because they cannot be in contact to mate with the female. I could witness their sexual frustration caused by this. I then took the liberty to educate them about sterilising the dogs, offering it at a cheaper rate, and that they are infringing on the CoJ by-laws relating to the Dogs and Cats. I also stressed the fact that Husky dogs are vocal dogs, which may also cause a noise nuisance to their neighbours, and need to find ways to manage such a nuisance. She did admit that they have too many dogs that they already allocated to family and friends that they will be fetching in the coming week. She denied claims of selling the dogs. She said she would speak to her husband to hear his plans with the dogs and get back to me.
