General Report Comments: The address provided was that of the complainant's. They described the incident and how it unfolded while pointing out the place of the scene. The incident is alleged to have happened next door to the complainant's residence. The dogs were reportedly tied up to a metal palisade fence with a blue and white rope(nylon) at house #41 Barnato Street, Berea. I met a few gentlemen loading up goods into a carriage trailer. The house appeared to be used as a loading point for Zimbabwean cross-border transporter. There were neither live animals nor were there any such dogs found upon inspecting it. The gents could acknowledge having witnessed the dogs but the so-called owner/culprit is unknown (or just couldn't reveal them to me). They stated that they never allow their customers to hand in live animals for transportation especially without proper documents presented. I still highlighted that this must never be allowed regardless as they can't account for someone's live animals as transported goods in their absence. No animals found.
