Comments: I met the kennel manager/master, Mr Philip Netshianda who walked me around the kennels. To some extent, things raised in my issued warning were being sorted out upon my follow-up inspection. On this visit, guard dogs needing urgent medical or veterinary care were my priority. The puppy with a swollen right eye was reportedly admitted to the Wendywood Vet, so were the rest of the guard dogs. "Snowy" was shaved and stitched on her left flank, while "Maddie" was medicated with Betamox for her bloody excretion. The kennel master stated that the older dogs, named "Bella" and "Rudy", did not seem to have any illness, as he believed that they were just old. He further mentioned that these dogs serve as demos for DH(Dog Handling) trainees who are scared of active guard dogs. I still insisted on dental and orthopaedic(especially bones and joints) check-ups. I informed the kennel manager about the fly infestation around their kennel facility, and he said they are using Cooper: Fly bait by spraying application. He was alerted to feeding frozen mince as a treat, which would attract more flies and not help control their population, and would maximise cases of 'fly-strike' as a result. The roof on Kennel row A to B was already being repaired, and pld straw was also being raked away from the cages. More maintenance and repairs were still underway. I was told that "Jim" was is a trained DH-1 safeguarding and patrolling dog/canine(K9) and he can respond to basic commands in this category of competency.
