General Report Comments: Body condition and possible bloating, The dogs observed did not present with signs consistent with neglect or malnutrition. Mr Pillay indicated that one dog has gained weight following sterilisation which can be consistent with increased appetite post-procedure. I recommend regular exercises for the dog. Food, water, and general care:At the time of inspection, there was no clear evidence indicating that the dogs were being deprived of food or water. No immediate welfare concerns were observed in this regard.Mr Pillay showed me dog food that is provided and fresh clean water. confinement, the conditions observed during the inspection dogs were free-roaming in the yardAllegations from third parties (neighbour assistance with feeding)I note the information provided regarding the neighbour. However, during the inspection, there was no direct evidence available to substantiate ongoing neglect in relation to feeding. I was informed by Mr Pillay that when his away he ask friends around the area to feed the dogs Veterinary care and historical concerns (including missing or deceased dogs):These concerns are noted. However, they could not be verified during the inspection and no records were presented at the time that indicated current welfare issues with the dogs present.Aggressive behaviour and removal challenges, I will follow up and assist removal of aggressive dog. Money circumstances alone are not sufficient grounds for intervention unless there is clear evidence that the animals welfare is being compromised At present , there are no grounds for enforcement action based on the findings of the inspection conducted on 18 April 2026. However, your concerns have been recorded. Should new, verifiable evidence arise indicating that the animals are at risk or being neglected, this office may reassess the situation and take appropriate action .
