Animals inspected:

150 cats

+ -20 pigs and piglets

+ - 30 geese

A full inspection of the facility and the animals was conducted in conjunction with the state vet. Overall conditions were acceptable, animals all have access to food, water and shelter. The following concerns were noted with several of the animals:

Older cats- recommended for euthanasia

1. Tortoise shell- Katy
2. 2x light grey tabby
3. Ginger feral
4. Plain grey
5. Dark tortoise shell
6. Black and white feral.

Veterinary:

1. Black female- hair loss and lump on lower stomach
2. Light ginger and white- eyes- suspect from sun irritation
4. Black and white kitten- underweight (cat dewormed on Site)
5. Elderly female pig- struggling to walk (vet treated on site)
6. 2x pig appeared to be mangy (ivemectin)
7. Male pig underweight- hamlet (ivemectin)
8. White cats- issues with the sun
9. 1x white and black cat- sunburn to the ears (under treatment)



None of the cats were displaying symptoms of panleukopenia at the time of the inspection and there was no indication of dead or dying cats on the property.

Annefrè advised that she no longer wishes to take in adult cats and will be mainly focusing on rehabilitating feral kittens for rehoming.

Follow up:

1. 6 of the 7 cats identified for euthanasia were brought in to the Centurion SPCA on 27th of January 2023. 1x feral could not be caught.
2. Pigs were sold at the auction
3. White cats were identified and taken indoors.
4. Annafrè advised that she will identify a second batch of cats for Euthanasia and will advise when she intends to bring them in.
5. Black female cat will be taken for treatment as soon as she can secure a free veterinarian assessment or be included in the euthanasia list.
6. 1x Pot belly pig female, appears to be doing better and will be monitored.

Recommendations:

1. Reduce the number of pigs on the property and only keep females and one sterilized male.
2. Reduce the number of cats on the property to a more manageable level. Focus mainly on younger less feral cats that are able to be rehomed.
3. Implement an admission and record system for all animals.
