Comments: Four dogs were found at the above address and the dogs were found in good conditions. The dogs also have sufficient food. The owner of the dogs admitted to the SPCA that his dogs does climb the wall using timber that is put against the wall, and then they climb on to the roof of their enclosure and then up to the wall. The dogs are however friendly. A notice was issued to the owner to remove timber from the wall to deny the dogs a way or access to reach the enclosure and to the top of the wall. There is no welfare concern. Investigation to be followed.

Below is photographic evidence of the findings at the above mentioned address during an inspection and after a follow up.



Fig 1.1 shows the four dogs found at the premise, the dogs were enclosed to prevent them from climbing the wall as the owner was in a process of removing timber they use to climb the wall.

Fig 1.3 shows the timber that the dogs uses to climb the wall.

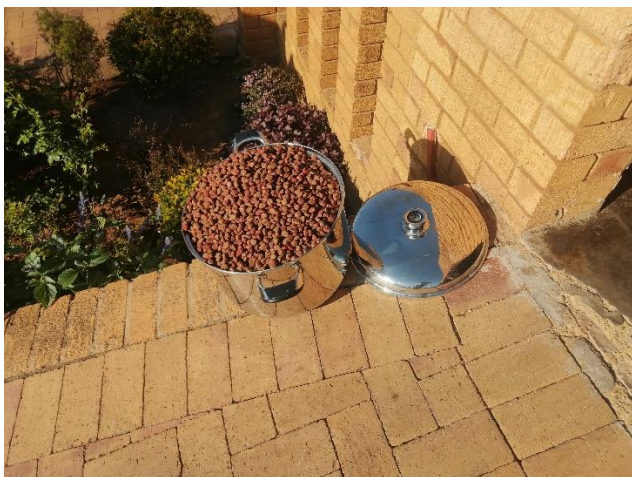


Fig 1.4 shows sufficient food available for the dogs at the premise.

Follow up

Date: 18.01.2023

During a follow up we found that the owner had complied, please see figure 1.5 to 1.7. The owner also reported that the dogs can no longer go up the enclosure nor the wall. All timber is removed from the ground close to the enclosure and the wall. The wall is at least 2.2 meters high. It is clear that the dogs will not be able to climb the neighbor's wall without timber to help them climb. We spoke also to the complainant who confirmed that since our visit, the dogs has never climbed the wall. No welfare concern, investigation was completed.
