Report/Findings:

The complaint has been received and investigated. A welfare inspection was conducted at the above address for the purpose of examining the condition of the dogs kept there. While at the property, we were acknowledged by the owner of the dogs named Ms. MA Gates and opportune to examine the condition of the dogs. A sum of two (2) adult dogs were found free roaming in the yard respectively and appeared to be in acceptable physical condition. Provision of adequate shelter, food and water was visually observed and within easy reach. We addressed the complaint at hand and Ms. Gates stated that yes she attempted to breed with her dogs before but such did not work. She further stated that the kids staying in the same

property were scared of the three small breed dogs she previously owned through which she was obliged to surrender the dogs to Wollies Animal shelter. The dogs in question were collected in December 2022 according to Ms. MA Gates. We continued to provide Ms. MA Gates with education in the plight of animals including sterilization. She intends to sterilize the dogs in future. Further, no welfare concerns were observed requiring immediate intervention from the society consequent to inspection. The conditions will be monitored more often than not in ascertaining that the said dogs welfare is not compromised.
