Report/Findings:

The complaint was investigated and at the time of inspection, a sum of seven (7) dogs were noticed in the property. Six (6) dogs were found to be kept on chains in the property that appeared to be heavy. Part of the place where the dogs were being kept was found to be up-kept. Upon enquiry into, as to why the dogs are confined to chains, the owner stated that he kept them on chains for the safety of the community and other dogs. The dogs were found to be in acceptable condition as per visual assessment and not underweight. Shelter was provided for all the dogs. Further, a four months old puppy was observed free

roaming in the property. Sufficient food and water were observed at the time of inspection and freely accessible. A warning was issued to the owner as to attend to the welfare concerns noticed and as alluded above.

A follow up inspection was undertaken and five (5) dogs were found in the property. Dogs were 3 adults, one 4 months old puppy and 5 months old puppy. Three dogs were found to be kept on chains. The owner has replaced the heavy chains with the light chains to collar as noticed consequent to inspection and also extended the length of the chains to the minimum of 5m long. The owner stated that with running wires the dogs might meet each other and possibly attack one another. With all that being said, the dogs were found to be in acceptable condition and they were sheltered, fed and watered adequately.
