There are two dogs on property and the dogs are roaming freely. The dog named Batman is kept in the enclose cos i had to drive in the property. The encloser is adequate size however the dog is not kept there all the time. They put the dog in this enclosure when they are driving out as the dog likes to exit the property and run on the road.

Both dogs are observed in a good condition and clinically alert. The dogs have access to drinkable water and the living environment is hygienic. There were no feaces seen and the dogs have access to adequate kennel. This property is adequately fenced.

I strongly believe the case can be closed as there is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962 and there is no further action that can be taken in terms of the act.
