General Report Comments: Upon arrival i hooted and shouted Caine came out.

I shared a nature of complain and he granted me access to enter the property. When you enter the property 1st dog named Mufasa is on the right hand side and on a static chain that is 7 meters long. Mufasa has access to adequate wooden kennel and water is provided. There are no feaces observed.

On the left handside when you enter the gate the 2nd dog is kept on the static chain that is 7 meters and the dog has access to adequate wooden kennel. Portable water is provided for the dogs and the living environment is hygienic.

Both dogs appears to be in a good condition and I questioned Caine why the dogs are on a static chain. He explained to me that the gate is malfunctioning and sometimes the gate opens itself which is a high risk during the day as there is a contruction outside their property. He fears the dogs will bite people however during might time they are roaming freely even though sometimes in the morning he finds the dog on the road. The property is not separated to keep the dogs at the backyard and the dogs are sterilized.

I strongly believe the case can be closed as the dogs can exhibit animal natural behavior in a long chain. There is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962. There is no further action that can be taken and case can be closed.
