General Report Comments: Upon arrival i met Sbonelo who is the worker and he told me that Chris is on his way. I then contacted Chris for confirmation and he told me he is 10 minutes away

We then waited for Chris and he arrived after 10 minutes. Chris granted me access to enter the property.

The property is now separated and one dog roams in the front yard. The dog in the front yard doesn't display any form of discomfort and it appears to be in a fair condition. The dog in the front yard is the one that was reported to be injured and the wound is located on the chest closer to the left leg. The wound is healing and it doesn't appear to be a wound that is deep. The dog was taken to the veterinarian on the 03/09 after the incident happened. Proof is attached. The living environment in the front yard is clean and the dog has access to adequate kennel. Portable water is provided for the dog in question.

We then went to the back yard where Max is kept and the entrance is via a gate. The property is separated and i observed Max. Max is clinically alert and there are no injuries on Max and the living environment is clean. Max has access to adequate kennel and portable water is provided. The living environment where Max is kept is adequate size as he can exhibit animal natural behavior.

Chris then shared how he got the dog. He claims he knows the complaint as she broke into her house and stated chaos wanting to beat up his wife. Chris got a dog from a friend as the owner of the dog passed away and Chris was approached by family members asking if he can rehome the dog. However Chris believes the complaint is jealous that he got the dog and the complaint told him she will contact SPCA to remove the dog. I further offered a Sterilisation to Chris and he told me that he will sterilize the dog later this year.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962. There is no further action that can be taken regarding the act. Case closed.
