She also feels SPCA is useless as she reported the matter and nothing has been done. I explained to her that SPCA does the welfare and metro police deals with the bylaws. She denied that her dogs are always on The road and they don't jump any fence.

She further explained that her dog had minor injuries on saturday when they woke up and she strongly believes in one of the neighbors dog that entered her property. I then requested she must call both dogs and no dog appears to be limping as both the dogs can apply pressure on the legs. The dogs Don't have external parasites and Mrs Ntuli showed me the ointment they applied on the wounds.

The dog in question doesn't have any open wounds and the dog is clinically alart.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. Both dogs are in the property and there is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962. There is no further action that can be taken.
