General Report Comments: Upon arrival i contacted Gaby to open the gate. She granted me access to enter the property and I shared a nature of complaint explaining that it about the walfare of the animals. She was with a tanent during my inspection.

When i told her that it has been mentioned that you have 34 dogs on the property. She laughed and granted me access to the house. We walked to the backyard where there is a build up of kennels.

3 adult dogs were observed in these kennels and there is sufficient space . The dogs can express animal natural behavior and water is provided for the dogs. The kennels are clean and hygienic. There are blankets provided for the dogs and according to Gaby she's moving to Palm beach. Gaby further stated that there is someone who comes and look after the dogs. Only 2 dogs will be left on the property of which the tanent will be looking after the dogs. According to Gaby 4 dogs have been moved to Palm Beach already.

We then went to the house as i requested to see puppies . Puppies were observed 4 in total and they appear to be in a good condition. There is a inferred light where the puppies are kept to ensure the heat is controlled. The puppies are kept in the house with the mother however the mother was kept in the separate entrance for my safety as she is very defensive. The dogs have adequate food provided and the puppies.

Gaby, tanent and i went outside. The mother was left to roam freely in the house and the mother dog came to the safety gate. Mother dog was observed in a good condition. Where the mother and puppies are kept is clean. There is no harmonic smell.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962. There is no further action that can be taken in terms of the law and the owner doesn't wanna sterilize the dogs. The case can be closed
