General Report Comments: Upon arrival I met Ryan who was at the property. He then told me that his boss told him I'll be doing an inspection, however Siyabonga who lives at the address outside the property was at the property with the tow guys.

The dog in question is named Simba and i was surprised when I saw he can reach the main road when the gate is opened. Simba is clinically alert and appears to be in a good condition. The rope that is extended with a chain is about 10 meters and Simba can cover 95% of the property. The chain is light as there is 5 meters rope that is used to ensure it not heavy for the dog. The living environment is clean and the dog has access to adequate shelter. According to Ryan They let the dog roam freely at night as the place is closer to the main road and Tow truck drivers sometimes leaves the gates opened.

There is a small scar around the neck and the dog got injured last friday when it was Diwali. It was trying to run away and Siyabonga used the chain to ensure the dog doesn't escape. It jumped the fence and there is a small scar around the neck. Panthox spray is used to ensure the scar doesn't get infected and it heals properly. Simba has access to portable water and adequate kennel that can protect him from all weather elements. Simba doesn't appear to be in pain and doesn't show any form of discomfort. Warren who is the owner of the dog went and bought a new leash also that is adequate to prevent injuries. It is not placed directly to the wound.
