General Report Comments: Lindo and myself went to the property, we were met by the worker Ali .there were 59cattle and 30 goats.all the animals appeared to be in acceptable condition. There were 10 x 1000kg of cow meal 3 x 1000kg molasses and 5 x 1000kg of crushed maize and there was no hay . They told us that they don't feed their animals hay . There were a lot of flies ,we advised them to hang up fly traps . We also forwarded the complaint to the Dept of health I spoke to Nomusa Ndlovu . On the 31 December we received another complaint that the cattle were getting underweight ,Lindo and myself returned to the property and found all the animals grazing in the property. we spoke to Ali he told us that they run out of cattle food ,they were waiting for it to come that afternoon . There were 6 cows that appeared to be very underweight . Petra and I returned to the property met with the animals tectichian Said and the owners, they showed us the food ,they told us they mixed the maize meal and crushed maize. And they also give molasses. They told us that some of the cows are thin because they calved and they also run out of food during the festive season. we told them to separate the underweight cows and cow with calves so that we can monitor them .there were fly traps and we also told him to do something about the mud in the runs .we will monitor it every weeks . Petra send them email with our concerns.
