General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I met Richard and i shared with him that we received a complaint that the clients are told to feed live rats if they own snakes. He denied ever saying that or any of his workers. He then called a quick meeting to educate his workers.

Reptiles:

Snake enclosures are observed and they are well secured in a case a kid tries to open the cages. The snakes have access to water and the hiding space is provided for the snakes in every enclosure. The lamps are covered and the temperature is thermostat controlled due to weather conditions. There is no snake that appears to be injured and the enclosures are clean.

Rodents:

Rats, mice, guinea pigs, and hamsters were observed. The cages are clean and hygienic. Hiding spaces are provided in each every cage and water is provided in every cage. None of these animals were observed to be sick or injured. There is also ventilation in the enclosures.

Fish:

Only 3 fish tanks were observed. There is no dead fish observed and the tanks have natural enrichments provided. The cages are not overcrowded and water is clean.

Birds:

No bird was observed to be sick or injured. The cages are fairly clean as the workers were busy cleaning bird cages. Adequate feeding is provided depending on species and chickens were seen. Every cage has perches and hanging water bows provided. The fans were off during this inspection where birds and chickens are kept. The window was open but there wasn't enough ventilation circulating and i instructed Richard to switch the fans on. He complied immediately and shouted at a guy who works in that section. I educated that the fans must always be left on so there will be enough ventilation flowing in this section.
