General Report Comments: I was accompanied by Field Officer Sipho to carry out the inspection at the address as he knows the area very well.

Upon inspection we met Nhlanhla who is induna in the area and he warmly welcomed us and he was with about 14 old man for his protection.

We shared a nature of complain and he explained to us that he had puppies that were sick however he contacted the state vet to come and treat the puppies. However the puppies were taken by a man and they were never returned. He believes the puppies didn't make it. Nhlanhla is now working hand in hand with the veterinarian that is located on Smith Street in Durban. That is where he learnt the puppies needs to be vaccinated to prevent the puppies from getting infected from diseases. Nhlanhla further explained that he didn't have this knowledge before up until he met the state vet and starting seeking for knowledge as he believes that he must look after his dogs very well cos they also protect him at night. 1 dog was at the property and 11 dogs were out with his kids as he also have cows. The boys are heading the cows during the day.

Adequate shelter is provided for the dogs and the living environment is clean. The property is not adequately fenced and the dog observed was roaming freely. The dog appeared to be in a good condition and healthy. Field officer Sipho took the details of Induna offering a sterilization and they will think about it.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and there is no further action that can be taken.
