General Report Comments: Upon arrival i hooted and the owner came to the gate.

I shared a nature of complain and he granted me access to enter the property. Two dogs were roaming freely in the front yard and they were observed in a good condition. The dogs have access to adequate shelter as a garage and portable water is provided for the dogs.

We then went to the backyard through a living room and one dog was observed roaming freely at the backyard. The dog has access to adequate kennel that can protect the dog from weather elements. There is a section that is fenced off with a gate and I questioned the owner why the dog was being reported that it is kept in that enclosure for 24 hours.

Malibongwe explained that there is gardner that works on property and he is afraid of dogs. The gardner works 3x a week (Monday, Wednesday and Friday). There is also a pool cleaning company that visits the property every friday to clean the swimming pool. The enclosure is only used when there are strangers on site and the two dogs in the front will be kept on the house.

Malibongwe further explained that the male dogs once fought and from there after paying the veterinarian bills. He decided to separate the dogs to ensure they don't ever fight again. Malibongwe isn't interested to surrender any dog or sterilize any dog.

I strongly believe the case can be closed as there is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962 and there is no further action that can be taken.
