On Sunday, they ensured to raise the fencing so the dogs don't jump into the neighbours house. New wire mesh has been added to the fencing to ensure the dogs are always confined. Two dogs were observed through the window and they appear to be in good condition. The living environment at the property is clean and hygienic. The dogs have two big kennels provided.

I then contacted the complaint after the inspection and he was relieved that the new fencing was installed so dog's don't enter his property.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962 and there no further action that can be taken.
