Joyce granted me access and the property is separated with a fencing. Where the dogs are kept there is no overgrown grass and this is a farm based on my judgment. Lot of trees and this is right place to own animals. Two dogs were observed and they appear to be in a good condition . The dogs are clinically alert and they have access to the house at all times. Trees provide extra shade for these dogs and no cats were observed as Joyce was feral cats rescuer. The cats are hiding during the day and they around this farm. Portable water is provided for these dogs. The living environment is clean as no feaces were observed. The dogs only barks when someone tries to enter the property cos many people have been trying to break in to this property according to Joyce.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962 and there is no further action that can be taken.
