The dog is on a running chain that is about 8 meters long and it can express animal natural behavior. I showed Natasha the Kennel and the runner. Her reply was she thought there was no Kennel it must've been placed this morning. I further explained to her this is the same kennel that was used when the dog was chained next to the main gate. She then told me she remembers when i first gave her feedback. She also confirmed the owners are working and they won't be home during the day. The dog in question appears to be in a good condition and good health.

To my surprise the complaint is about the barking of the dog . According to Natasha it barks every night and she is struggling to sleep. I then told her that dogs bark when they see someone or see something. The barking complaint must be reported to Metro Police as they enforce the City bylaws. She then ask for my advise and I informed her that she must send an email.

I strongly believe the case can be closed. There is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962 and there is no further action that can be taken.
