General Report Comments: Upon arrival i hooted and one of the workers named John came to the gate. I explained to him that i came to see Natasha and he went to the main house to call her on my behalf.

Natasha came with her husband and they granted me access to enter the property. I entered the property and I shared a nature of complaint. Natasha told me that she has nothing to hide. She showed me the clinical cards that her dogs are fully vaccinated and she is a registered breeder.

She then showed me the medication that she uses on her dogs. She opened one shelf that has Nexguard, Petshop Tick and flea spot on, Dewormers, Tick and Flea spray. There is a lot of medication for the dogs under her custody and you can see the medication was not recently bought. The dogs are also given vitamins at times.

Natasha has hired John who lives on site full time and when she is at work John cleans the property. John also look after the dogs during the day and when you enter the house it smells fresh.

In total on this property there are 6 adult dogs. 5 females and one male dog. Natasha than gave me a letter from ST. JOHNS veterinarian and on the letter it is stated that i can call the veterinarian at any time if i wanna know about Natasha's dogs.

There dogs were separated as they were trying to attack me while i was on the property. Natasha than explained to me that on Friday two dogs had a fight Emily and a female dog that has a litter of puppies.

On my observation the female dog was roaming around in and out of the house. The dog appears to be in a good condition and clinically alert. There are no visible injuries observed. Lot of kennels are placed on the property to ensure the dogs has access to shelter at all times during the day. The dog has a newborn litter of puppies and all her dogs don't give birth naturally. They go to St. Johns veterinarian for C Section. 7 puppies were observed kept warm in the bedding and John was busy cleaning. 5 more adults dogs were observed and they appear in good health. Natasha's husband and John has to use one of the holding kennels to ensure i don't get attacked but 3 aggressive dogs they own.

Also on these holding kennels clean water is provided. Bedding is provided and the dogs are in a good condition. According to Natasha she gives her dogs tick and flea medication after 3 months. John also dip the dogs once a month.

I then questioned Natasha about the dog named Emily. She started from the beginning regarding the dog named Emily and she stated that Emily was starting to be an alpha female. She will start a fight with a female dog that has a litter of puppies and Natasha decided to rehome her as she was starting to cause problems. The dog fought on friday morning and she was contacted by John who works at her house. Natasha has an assistant named Dana who assist in finding customers for Natasha. Natasha was also introduced to Nirvana who runs ISIPINGO PET RESCUE.

According to Natasha when she heard the dogs fought. She contacted Dana and Nirvana quickly jumped to assist as was the first on the list to be a new owner of Emily. That is how the dog ended up on the veterinarian.

I then questioned about the eye problem and an ear infection. Natasha responded When she recognized the dog has a ear infection and eye problem Nirvana suggested it better is a dog is seen by a veterinarian she normally use which is Montclair vet.

On my findings it wasn't the 1st time Emily went to the Montclair vet. On the 12/06/2025 the dog in question named Emily was at the veterinarian and she received medication for eyes and ear infection. Natasha was furious as she claims that she paid for that medication and the dog was also given external parasites control (Nexguard) I further question if she does have proof that she paid for medication and also I need pictures of the medication. All the evidence is attached on the case that the dog was under which treatment and PDF is proof of payment is attached. Nirvana took the dog to Saint John's vet and Natasha paid for the medication.

I did more investigation about Emily at St. Johns veterinarian and i spoke to Dr LR Bainbridge who runs the practice. Based on Dr Bainbridge it happens to most Bulldogs to have enlarged heart and Natasha always uses St. Johns for her dogs. Last time Emily was at St. Johns veterinarian is earlier this year February and Emily was in for a surgery as Natasha's dogs don't give give birth naturally. She always pay for Surgery (C Section)

Natasha also mentioned that Nirvana and Dana wanted the newborn puppies. She declined them to own the puppies as they are new borns and they are lactating from a mother. She believes that where the problem started and after Natasha got a call from SPCA she also Declined Nirvana to own the dog named EMILY

Dr Bainbridge cannot provide medical history of medical history of the dog in question without approval from the Natasha. I contacted Natasha and she said she will get the history for me.
