He has a problem with the dog in question as it causing damage to his vehicle. The dog in question doesn't have any injuries and there is no form of discomfort that was observed.

I issued a notice

It has been brought to attention that you were seen hitting the dog with a plank. If we should receive any evidence supporting these allegations of you hitting any animal. It will lead into action taken against you for being in contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962.

Two dogs were left on the property and they are in good health . The dogs are clinically alart and have access to water. Adequate shelter is also provided for these dog.

I strongly believe the case can be closed as there is no contravention of the animals protection act 71 of 1962 and there is no further action that can be taken.
