General Report Comments: Upon arrival I was met with the owner who immediately started to explain that a feud has started between him and the owner next door. For years he has been using the property and the three big dogs were kept there, confined in adequate space enclosures during the day and roaming the property at night at number 5. The night before he was forced to relocate the dogs to number 3 where there is now insufficient space. The three small dogs were roaming around with full access to property. At night they sleep inside the shop with adequate space and couches for sleeping areas. They were scratching a lot. Owner said he did provide Bravecto in January. Educated to provide again also other alternatives like Karbodont and Dip. The fox terrier was dirty of all the cars but no oil just black dust. The two cats are apparently only strays he is feeding. The three dogs at the back are each kept in an approximately 1m x 0.5 meter enclosure each. Each had a cardboard and clean water. He agrees that the situation is not ideal and he is busy with arrangements either moving them back next door or his private property. Big dogs also scratching also educated on parasite prevention. Also asked to place pallets as extra bedding. Gave office number for sterilization and my number to keep me updated as to what the solution is with the big dogs and send proof of parasite prevention.
