General Report Comments: Was met with a volunteer. There is 11 enclosures already with animals in in process of building more. The enclosures is apporx 3m x 3m each, wire mesh and zink for roof. Gravel in process to lay either cement or pavement. Busy with blinds and shade cloth to but up behind enclosures. All kennels had adeqaute wooden kennels with straw in. All kennels had clean water buckets. Variety between two to 5 dogs per enclosure, overcrowding already a concerns since there is also more dogs needing to come to the property but I were told that they will build sufficient enclosures so they do not overcrowd. Compatibilty so its either same sexes or some sterilised enclosed together to avoid breeding. All animals appeared to be in fair conditions. Only three females ( Sharpei and black cross breed one enclosure and another white female in enclosure next with three other dogs) had skin conditions. Left my number with volunteer to send proof of medication as he said they do apply medication daily he is just unsure. Total of 36 dogs
