Are they slaughtered Yes they were slaughtered for personal use not for Qurbani
13. Do holding pens overlook slaughter areas They do, they did however make an attempt to shield the area with shade netting
14. Is shade provided For the goats and sheep yes

Slaughter – Small Stock (Goats and Sheep)

15. Are animals handled humanely (no dragging / kicking etc) Unfortunately not on numerous occasions this was addressed, they have been issued with a warning

16. Type of animals being used Goats and sheep
17. Is animal held properly for slaughter Unfortunately not on numerous occasions this was addressed, they have been issued with a warning
(not knelt on etc)
18. Is bleeder ready to slaughter Not all the time as they moved away to sharpen knives, this was addressed and attempt was made to improve on this, this is mentioned in the warning
19. Is knife sharp and adequate size For the sheep and goats yes
20. Is knife sharpened regularly For the sheep and goats not enough this was addressed and is mentioned in the warning
21. Is slaughterer competent Yes when sharp knives are used, he also oversees any public member wanting to slaughter
22. If more than 2 strokes – why Blade not being sharpened
23. Does dressing of the carcass take place once bleeding is complete and there are no signs of life Yes
24. The sides of bleeding pit where cut takes place – is it cleaned, hosed or blood covered with sand (no pools of blood) between cuts An attempt to cover the bleeding pit with sand is made but constant reminders are required, this is mentioned in the warning as well as recommendations

Large Animals (Cattle)

25. Are animals enclosed to ensure less stress Cattle are kept in a paddock and then moved to a smaller holding area sadly the public hang over this area and stress the animals out. The public were addressed about this on numerous occasions
26. Are animals handled humanely No, they are beat and prodded and warning was issued for excessive and incorrect use of the prodder, guidance is offered within the recommendations for this
27. Type / age of animals used Adult cattle
28. Prodders / sticks used Yes, this was addressed and warning issued
29. How are animals restrained to allow bleeding Animals are bled out partially in the slaughter box and then tilted out to bleed out further on the ground.
30. Method of holding neck to expose jugular Initially nose hook but this was changed to rope as per Jason's request/ suggestion
31. Is slaughterer prepared to bleed Not all the time as they moved away to sharpen knives, this was addressed and attempt was made to improve on this, this is mentioned in the warning
32. Is knife sharp and adequate size Initially no, the correct knife size was used after instruction to do so reminders to sharpen were needing to be made
33. How often is knife sharpened The knife was sharpened but not between each cut, this was addressed
34. Is slaughterer competent Yes when using correct knife
35. If more than 2 strokes – why Incorrect knife and not sharp enough
36. Does dressing of animal take place while life signs still showing No
37. Is the area used for bleeding cleaned between each animal No

Comments This site needs a lot of attention but has attempted to make improvements since 2021, I will be offering

recommendations for further improvement going forward and will work with them to ensure a more compliant Qurbani for 2023
