General Report Comments: Unfortunately, the trapping of feral dogs is a very big challenge. These dogs are usually unaccustomed to human contact, move around constantly, and are extremely cautious of capture. Safely catching them requires a lot of time, specialized equipment, and staff, which are resources we sadly do not have at present.

While we may not always be able to remove these animals immediately, we continue to monitor cases like this closely and work within our capacity to address situations of cruelty and neglect. Where feral dogs pose an immediate risk to public safety, we encourage residents to also report the matter to the local municipality and SAPS so that a broader response can be coordinated.
