General Report Comments: Summary of Visit:
The owner, Mr. Iphram, advised that he has been residing on the property for approximately six years. He keeps a herd of cattle and a flock of sheep, and one Pitbull cross was observed on the premises.

The cattle had just returned to the kraal after grazing in the neighbouring fields, while the sheep were still out grazing. Mr. Iphram does not have a herder and manages all the livestock himself.

The Pitbull is kept on a static chain but is in satisfactory physical condition. It was discussed that a running chain will be erected to allow the dog better movement, and a proper kennel will be provided.

Kraal Conditions:

The cattle kraal is clear of stones and any harmful objects.

The sheep kraal is adjacent to the cattle kraal.

Mr. Iphram showed us corrugated iron sheets he has purchased to build a shelter for the sheep.

The area where the cattle graze does contain some stones, though it was noted that none of the cattle were resting in those sections.

A metal bath is used as a water trough for the cattle.

Mr. Iphram also showed us the medications he keeps on hand for when animals fall ill.

Assistance and Follow-up Plan:
It was agreed that Springs SPCA will assist Mr. Iphram with:

Providing a second water trough for the cattle.

Supplying a proper kennel and establishing a running chain for the dog.

Field Officer Paulos will oversee this case due to the language barrier , and it will be managed as part of our outreach programme.

Paulos has been instructed to:

Ensure that Iphram clears away the stones from the cattle holding area.

Identify practical ways to improve the current setup to enhance the comfort and welfare of the animals.

A follow-up visit will be conducted in one month's time to monitor progress and assess improvements made.
