General Report Comments: After leaving a Notice to Comply (NTC) at the property, Field Officer Lenka returned to conduct a follow-up visit. Upon arrival, he managed to gain access to the premises.

Lenka attempted to explain to the occupants that tying up a duck constitutes a violation of the Animals Protection Act (APA). However, due to the language barrier and the fact that the individuals were foreign nationals, communication proved to be extremely challenging.

During the interaction, he was able to establish that the occupants intended to slaughter the duck for a meal. Field Officer Lenka proceeded to untie the duck and removed the cord from the property to prevent further harm or re-restraint.
