General Report Comments: Mrs Hendriekz explained the entire back story of the Sharpei dog. Two years prior the dog belonged to the neighbours who left her behind after moving out. The family decided to take the dog in but soon realised she suffers from severe anxiety. Her triggers are weather, water, loud screaming and shouting. When the weather changes she loses body condition. Mrs Hendriekz showed me multiple photos over a year and half span of how the body condition fluctuates. I was also shown invoices from Welgelegen Animal Clinic in Nigel. The dog had been to see Dr Cindy and was given vitamins and calming tablets. The dogs are fed a diet of Bobtail pellets. All the other dogs on the property are in satisfactory condition. With regards to the fly strike, the owners have two different sprays, Shoofly and a homemade recipe. I was informed that they find the shoofly does not affectively work therefore they are trying a homemade recipe. Mrs Hendriekz then complained that the neighbours are constantly feeding the dogs over the wall with all sorts of pellets, cooked food and treats, resulting in some of the dogs vomiting or getting gastros. I was shown videos of the dogs vomiting pap. I informed Mrs Hendriekz that I would be conducting a follow up in two weeks to see if the dog's body condition is improving or not.
