Provided guidance on proper animal care, including nutrition, shelter, and disease prevention

A follow-up visit is scheduled for next week to cover another section of the area

Actively contacting owners of female dogs to encourage participation in sterilization programs

Continued efforts to improve animal welfare and strengthen community awareness
