General Report Comments: The front and sides of the property are enclosed with precast walls with the back of the plot being closed off with steel fencing. A section of the garden containing the pool is walled off from the rest of the plot; however, the dogs do not go there, the dogs free roam the plot. Located in different areas of the plot, large kennels are placed in shaded areas. Large buckets of water are located near the back door. All four dogs are in satisfactory body condition. The great dane has a recovering wound, a few weeks prior the dog went to the vet to have the wound stitched up. The scar is visible and the hair in the process of growing back. One of the Tibetan Mastiffs needs to still go for an eye surgery to cut the inward growing lashes causing eye irritation. The vet used by the family is either Rietkol Vet or Bapsfontein Vet. The boerboel apparently grew up with a cat that was adopted from Wet Nose Animal Shelter, but the cat was euthanased a year ago from kidney failure due to old age. The adopter assured me that the cats would be indoor cats but with very slow introductions to the dogs.
