The dog was on a long chain under a tree. Mrs Senosi informed me that the dog was chained for the duration of the grass being cut as all the gates are open. In the corner of the yard was a wooden kennel. Near the back door two bowls, one filled with water and one filled with pellets was present. I was told the dog is fed a diet of Juava pellets. Normally the dog is free roaming only in the back yard, as the back yard is separated from the front yard. The dog only gets chained when the garden service are there. The dog appeared to be in satisfactory body condition.
