General Report Comments: The entire property is enclosed with brick walls with electric fencing on top, totalling a height of 1.8m-2m. The front and back yards are not separated and there is a swimming pool in the back yard. Near the back door two kennels underneath a roofed area are present. In the laundry room beds and blankets are present for the dogs. There is also a doggy door in the security door by the back door. Water bowls were found outside and inside the house. In the stoep area on the other side of the house, one large bird cage was present containing the African Grey. The flooring was covered with newspaper, and the food and water bowls were clean and filled. The African Grey was in satisfactory condition with no feather loss or behavioural issues noticed. The cage had multiple enrichment objects within. Inside the house in the lounge another large cage was present containing a Red Rump Parrot. The flooring was covered with newspaper and the food and water bowls were clean and filled. Also multiple enrichment objects were within. The applicant informed me that both birds get taken out their cages to interact with her on a daily basis and that they are fed a varied diet of seed, legumes and veggies.

I discussed the implications of having a "breeding" pair on the property as the Dachshund female was not sterilised yet and neither the Toy Pom male. The applicant informed me that she will not sterilise the female dog before the age of 6 months; therefore, we agreed to have the male sterilised before the adoption is finalised.
