One cat resides permanently with the applicant, while the other has moved in with a neighbour but continues to visit the applicant regularly. Both cats are female. The cat staying with the applicant is sterilised, whereas the cat residing with the neighbour remains unsterilised.

It was noted that no litter box is provided inside the applicant's home. Instead, the cats are using the outdoor flower bed as a toilet area, which has resulted in visible pollution with cat faeces.
