Nature of Complaint: Conduct welfare of the tigers, ocelot and vultures kept at the Benoni Monkey and Bird Park.

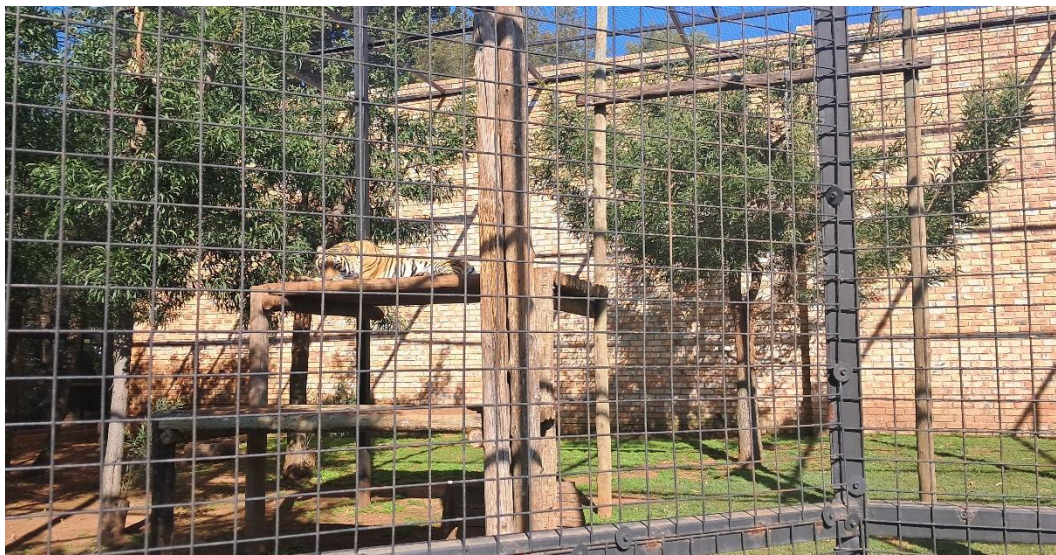
Inspection conducted by **Inspector Thomas Mohlake.**

Total number of animals found on the property

- +/- 200 Birds (different species)
- +/- 50 Geese/ducks (different species)
- 3 × Tigers
- Ocelot
- +/- 40 Monkeys (different species)

Findings on the 10 July 2025 (10h20)

Tigers × 3 (1 male sterilised (± 6 years old), and 2 adult females)



- The enclosure where the tigers are kept is well maintained.
- The tigers did not show any sign of distress during my investigations.
- They appeared to be in good condition.

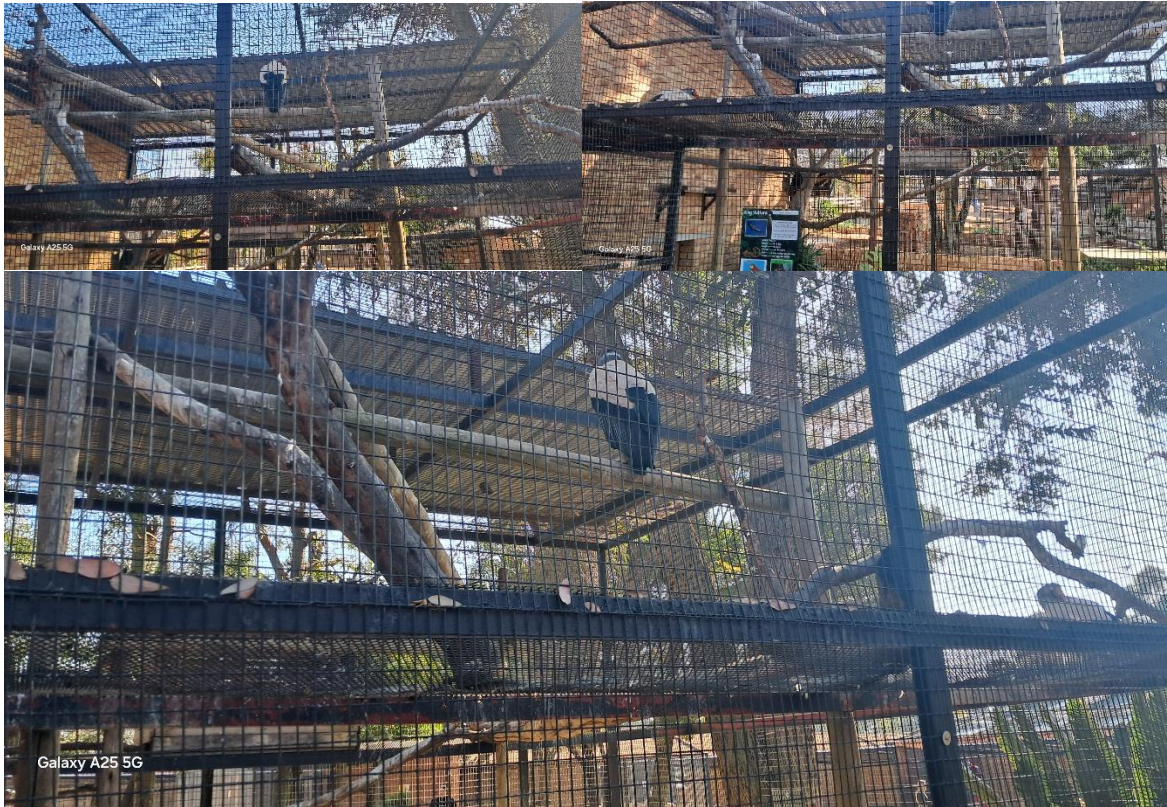

Ocelot (male) 9 years old



- The enclosure where the ocelot is kept is divided into two. The space appeared to be adequate.
- The ocelot was sleeping during the time of my investigation. The owner woke it up, but it went back into its kennel to continue sleeping.
- It did not show sign of being distressed.

Vultures ×3



- The enclosure where the vultures are kept appeared to have adequate space and they were observed flying from one perch to another.

Action taken

- I could not find any welfare concerns.
