General Report Comments: Upon arrival, I was accompanied by Senior Inspector Moyo Ndukwana (SPCA CEO). The owner was not present. One of the workers contacted the owner. We waited approximately 5 minutes for the owner to come to the yard.

The owner, Ms Selma Hanekom, and her husband arrived. Driving a bakkie with registration number CW67763. I explained to the owner the reason for our visit and our concern about the one horse being emaciated. The owner showed us medication she is using to treat the horse for stomach ulcers (Omeprazole - medication). The owner claimed this was the reason for the horse being emaciated and that the horse still has a good appetite. The owner confirmed that the horse was not seen by a veterinarian.

The other two horses were in acceptable condition. All three horses had hoove issues and need to be seen by a farrier.

The owner was issued with a written warning for the following:

- 1) To seek veterinary care for the dark bay thoroughbred called Lala who is emaciated within 96 hours.
- 2) A farrier needs to attend to the hooves of all three horses within 7 days.

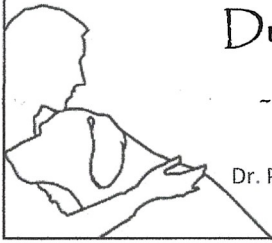

The horse was seen by Dr De Wet of Durbanstraat Dierekliniek .

Dr De Wet confirmed that the horse is in poor condition . A special diet has been prescribed . The horse must be dewormed and must be seen by an equine dentist and the horse is already under treatment for stomach ulcers - on antibiotics. The veterinarian also confirmed that the hooves of the horse was also done.

A follow-up needs to be done in 3 weeks.
