I then let willow off leash and she enjoyed the large space to run in and explore. Bismarck mostly played with her and calmed down immensely. Je seemed to like her and the two older dogs were also fine. Maya kept barking but did smell Willow.

We went back inside and then Maya immediately went back into her protection mode. I educated them to keep an eye on Maya and Willow and they were fine with this.

They feed their dogs Royal Canin and I informed them that she needs her second injection on Friday. They were very chill and said they will take her on Friday and get her Bravecto etc. they also plan to sterilize Maya when she is older. They use Bergzicht Vet in Malmesbury.

Jan plans to take Willow with everywhere on the farm in his bakkie.

He signed the contract after I explained it to him and said he will pay later the day. Willow really seems to like Jan.
