In light of my inspection conducted on the 31st of July 2024, the following concerns were observed and must be rectified as discussed, by 30 September 2024 unless stated otherwise. See Meat Safety Act 40 Of 2000 and the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962.

You are hereby warned that:

1. The cattle slaughter run and sheep offloading ramps did not have gridding/non-slip flooring. Ensure to install non-slip flooring in the runs and offloading ramps to prevent unnecessary injuries to the animals.
2. Ensure to install non-slip flooring in the cattle crush in the form of drainage rubber mats or gridding to prevent unnecessary injury to the cattle being slaughtered. The current floor is not sufficient as non-slip flooring.
3. The cattle crush has a metal sheet on the inside that is protruding at the bottom that can cause unnecessary injury to the cattle being slaughtered. Ensure to fix or replace this metal sheet.
4. We observed the feral cats close to the slaughter areas and they appeared to be diseased. This is a concern for the health and safety of the Red Meat abattoir. Ensure to provide the cats with veterinary treatment **within 48 hours** or schedule a date with the Wellington SPCA to trap and remove the cats from the premises.

We remind you to adhere to all the provisions of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935 (as amended in 2016) & its supporting Regulations and the City of Cape Town Animal Keeping By-Law at all times.

This warning has been issued in terms of the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 169 of 1993.

Failure to comply with this warning may render you liable for prosecution under the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 and/or Performing Animals Protection Act 24 of 1935.

Any person who:- obstructs, hinders or resists an officer authorised in terms of the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962 or conceals any animal shall be guilty of an offence in terms of Section 8(4) of the aforementioned Act.
