General Report Comments: Hugh and I, Elani arrived at the property and was assisted by Rolf as Zhuzhu dpreferred not to interact with us and Rolf speaks English better.

We first went to the smaller bird cages and I clarified to him what I meant with cleaning with the pressure hose by taking birds out and that that only needs to be done once in a while. I also explained about the octagon shaped cages and showed why the lifted cages and cages with trays are easier to clean. I told him the can srill cut a square shape to fix it and in the long run it will be easier to clean the cages like that.

I also explained what needs to be cleaned daily and this includes the food bowls, water bowl and loose food and faeces that was messed on the floor for the day. They can spray F10 afterwards on the floor.

He understood this. I asked about the second big aviary and when they will use it. Rolf said he will speak to Zhuzhu but thinks she wants to split the bigger birds through those cages. We spoke about making the enclosures natural and maybe putting the smaller birds in an avaiary depending if they get along.

We then went to the small cages next to the aviary next to the house . The rusted cage was emptied from birds and cleaned very well. I was impressed about the difference than the previous visit . I showed Rolf what I meant with the rust etc and that they might need to coat the metal with antirust paint before using it again. He then showed the cahe with the patches of roof that needs to be covered with a solifld piece. We then agreed even if half of the cage has a closed roof and a dry side it would be better already. I showed the tray cages again to show its easier to clean. He understood.

I then looked at the big aviary and could see they pressure hosed the walls as the algae is basically gone. The only mess was where the birds eat their food that gets cleaned daily. I did not see one bird hanging from the roof or on the sides as they added additional perching cable ropes, metal stands and swings. The birds look much happier and relaxed being spread out like this.

We then went back to the main house and thanked Rolf that he worked with us and asked when we can come back for a follow up on the cages and the second aviary being filled and he said the summer would be better.

We then agreed to vome back in November to see how they have improved the birds living conditions. He agreed and said we must let him know closer to the time.

Zhuzhu complied as the bird cages were much cleaner today than previous visits. I would see the difference in creativity and effort.

To follow up in three months.
