General Report Comments: Hugh and I, Elani arrived at Oude Wellington as Marle drove out. I redorded the entire inspection. She confirmed Annemie is waiting for us. We went inside and met with Annemie and introduced ourselves.

She was very hostile about my previous warnings and kept saying we should make appointments with her and that shelter is not her priority. She kept on asking whether we see any horse in distress or bad condition. I decided to give her a rundown on the Animals Protection Act 71 of 1962, the definitions, Section 2(1) and Section 8. She also mentioned we cannot just pitch up and need to make appointments and I explained to her that is not how we work.

We walked through every single camp to check the perimeters and whether the trees are inside or outside the enclosure. There was only one envlosure that had multiple trees inside for shelter.

Annemie explained that she had yo have specific shadecloth made with spring clamps for the wind from Johannesburg and that half of the stock arrived already.

After looking at all the envlosures including yhe ones with the poles inside, she mentioned that she will be able to have one envlosures shelter phone within the next two weeks. We agreed on this and ahe agreed that I can check her progress. I also mentioned multiple times she is more than welcome to send the list of other studs in the area that is similar to hers. She said she will be here for the next 6 months except over Christmas. I also mentioned to jer that she must train her guys to clean the enclosures thoroughly from faeces at least once a week as I would see that they do neglect this. They have 4 grooms currently working there and Marle.

Long term she plans to build stables.

To check the progress on shelter within 2 weeks as agreed upon.
