General Report Comments: Elani and I,Hugh arrived at the property and we were greeted by Jane Morris. We then introduced ourselves and explained that we had got a complaint about the dogs there.She then allowed us to come inside the house to check on the animals.

As I was walking through the house I then noticed an African Grey parrot .We then proceeded to the dogs.

We could see that the area was a large area and big enough for the two large breed dogs .When asked whether the dogs were sterilized Jane told us that they are not sterilized neither is the small cockerspaniel roaming the yard.I then told them that if she goes in heat the male dogs might fight amongst each other.She then told me that they don't actually fight with each other but I could see one of the dogs growling at the other at some point.The welfare of the dogs wasn't a problem and we educated them to atleast have them enjoy the rest of the yard more frequently.

We then went inside and inspected the cage where the African Grey named Kiki was held .We could see that the cage in the bottom had excess faeces and excess food laying in the bottom.Elani then asked to see the food that they were feeding Kiki and it was mainly sunflower seeds.Elani then educated them on this and asked that they change the food gradually over these few days which they agreed to.We also asked them to add some more environmental enrichment in the cage and they agreed.

Warning 063 was then issued to:

- 1.KK was seen eating a high fatty diet(sunflower seeds).Change his food over slowly to a species specific diet including more fruit within 72 hours.
- 2.Clean KK's cage thoroughly from excess faeces within 72hours.
- 3.Provide KK with more environmental enrichment within 72hours.
