I asked whether she has money to at least buy dewormer and she bought dewormer for Leila from us fo R30. I issued her with a second warning to:
1) Provide Leila with adequate food within 7 days (Ensure to buy Bobtail puppy food).
She only gets paid on Friday and did not want to surrender Leila. I educated her on what house good to feed and what not to feed.

We went to follow up whether Buksie has been placed on a running chain . We saw that they bought a collar, built a running chain and got a broken kennel for Buksie. He still tangled himself arounf the pole so therefore we assisted in placing the kennel on the one side of the tunner to prevent him getting tangled up. As they worked together with us we decided to bring yhem a donated kennel tomorrow. They also surrendered one of their cats and the other dog.

We noticed next to Louise that they also got a new puppy called Milo that was kept on a rope without shelter, water and tangled around structure. We loosened the puppy so he can move around more. The son named Charlton was home and I explained everything to him and also asked him to bring the dog water. He did and Milo immediately drank water. I issued a warning for them to:
1) Provide Milo with water at all times
2) Ensure to provide Milo with a running chain within 7 days/ enclose the back yard to let him toam freely.
3) Provide Milo with an adequate shelter within 7 days (waterproof roof, three sided walls and raised flooring)
Charlton signed the warning.
