General Report Comments: I, Elani obtained the court order from the Magistrates Court.

Hugh and I then went to SAPS to get Sgt Pietersen and Sgt Tshulo for assistance from Wellington SAPS.

We then went to the property and hooted for the owners attention as the front door was open . Ashton came out and I explained to him that I am there with a court order and the reason why we decided to confiscate Bo. He got very upset and kept on asking why. I stayed calm and explained the court order to him whilst walking towards Bo. Hugh took pictures of the dog and its living conditions and removed Bo from the property whilst I issued the Seizure Notice. Ashton kept shouting that we are taking the dog just because its on the chain. SAPS were very calm and told him that we have a court order and he must listen to us.

I issued the seizure Notice which Ashton signed and explained that they can call and claim the dog within 7 days according to Regulation 468. Hugh also removed the chain from the property.

We admitted Bo to the SPCA.

We then went to SAPS and obtained OB number 2138/11/2024.

We barely offloaded Bo at the SPCA when Ashtons mother named Venetia Adams , cell no 0604550820, ID# 8512290147087, arrived to claim Bo. She was argumentative in a way that we should go to other places to help animals and that they love the dog but do not have money to buy a running chain and does not know what it is. I explained to her on detail what it is and argued why didnt she call us once if she cared about her dog and saw the warnings. She also mentioned that she works at the school and her husband at a construction company. I told her that they need to fix what I asked for before I think about returning the dog to them or I can prosecute them.

She understood and left and said she will inform us when everything is ready.

Yo follow up within 7 days on progress if they havent contacted us in the meantime.
