We then spoke to her husband and he fed the horses to give Selma the peace she needed. Andries then tried getting the horses away from Lala so that we could walk her in another direction. We then started walking and could see Lala getting really stressed. She then wanted to go back to the other two horses. Andries then called Selma and she came down. She started walking the horses in another direction. Thereafter the municipality came and they started digging a hole on the property in order to bury her.

Andries then walked Lala to the back where we waited until the hole was fully dug.

The municipal worker then gave the go ahead and we started making a video in order for me Hugh Lewis to get my LAE for NSPCA.

We then went ahead and shot the horse with the Captive bolt pistol and let it bleed out. We then cut open the stomach in case of built up gases.

We then had the digger come and get Lala and bury her in the already dug hole. We then went back and Selma was distraught but also mentioned she understands.

We then walked the two other horses into their walking ring as they were too stressed to be in the field where they were.

We then greeted Selma and Andries. They then greeted us and we left.
