General Report Comments: Hugh and I, Elani arrived at Uitkijk Farm to remove the stitches of the 15 dogs that was sterilized by us and do a general check on all the houses with animals. Cathleen assisted us by Uitkyk and Vredelust.

We first did Uitkijk. We removed all the animals stitches. She informed us that Max and Tyson is sick. Max was lethargic and peeing blood and Tyson was also pale and lethargic. I called Liz to confirm whether we can take the animals to WAGH and she confirmed.

On Uitkijk side we issued 2 warnings as follows:

Warning 034:
House 19, Sakkie Josias (cell no 0836935561):
Ensure to provide Willie with adequate shelter within 7 days (three sided walls, raised flooring, waterproof roof).

Warning 035:
House 13, Charlene Heyns (cell no 0665952140):
1) Ensure to provide Sento with adequate shelter and running chain within 7 days.
2) Ensure Sento always has access to water (place bucket in tyre/ brick filled crate to prevent knockover)

At Vredelust we issued 2 warnings as follows:

Warning 036:
House 3, Pieter Willemse
1)Provide Bonzo with a running chain and adequate shelter (three sided wall, waterproof roof, raised flooring) within 7 days.
2) Ensure Bonzo always have access to water (place bucket in tyre/crate to prevent knockover)

Warning 037:
House 8, Sophie
1) Ensure to fix the enclosure to prevent the dog to jump over the fence within 7 days. Refrain from chaining the dog at all times.
2) Provide potable water for your dog at all times.

There were 3 people requesting to surrender their animals. Two people asked to dewormer their dogs (House 3 and 8) -3 pills

We gave the people leashes, bowls, harnesses and collar.

We then admitted Max and took him to WAHG and back (Receipt # G1/95).

We then admitted Tyson and took him to WAGH and back (Receipt #G1/96).

To pick up 3 surrenders tomorrow and follow up within 7 days on warnings.
