We then arrived at the property where Sento was kept and we noticed that none of our demands on the previous warning had been met.We then called outside and her daughter came outside to greet us.We then explained to her the seriousness of the previous warning and she understood .

We then issued warning 029 to:

- 1.Provide Sento with a running chain within 7 days.
- 2.Provide Sento with adequate shelter within 7 days(3 sided with raised flooring,waterproof roof)

Elani and I,Hugh then decided to go and check up on the other dog named Luka who was not well either(provided medication for them).When we went passed we noticed Luka on a static chain and Anneline Skippers son arrived.We then asked him why Luka was on a chain he then mentioned he gets out and fights with other dogs.We then explained to him that we expect him to be on a running chain and also asked him how the dog is doing and he said he is fine and healthy.

We issued warning 030 to:

- 1.Provide Luka with a running chain within 7days as he is kept in a static chain.

We then drove towards Vredelust to recheck whether they complied with the previous warnings .

Elani and I,Hugh arrived at Vredelust and we were then greeted by Christine Sias .We introduced ourselves and noticed that they had not complied with the previous warning. We then asked whether they had atleast got the wire in order to build the runner and she said that they haven't.

Warning 031 was issued to:

- 1.Provide Bollie with a running chain within 7days.

We then moved towards Andre's house.When we arrived there we called and it seemed there was no one home but we could see the dog from the gate.The dog was moved and had adequate shelter built but the dog was still on a static chain.

Warning 032 was issued to:

- 1.Provide a running chain for your dog within 7 days or let him roam freely as he is on a static chain.
