Elani the approached him and he then said he was in a hurry because he needed to arrive at tomis abbatoir.She then explained to him that he cannot transport a bull in the conditions that he is transporting it.

He then gave her his phone to speak to his boss Stefan Lombard.She then explained to him that the animal needs to be humanely euthanized as it cannot be transported any further like this.He then understood and agreed to have it done right there.

We then asked the guy with the truck to turn to the side of the road and he did so .We then worked on a plan to get the bull to the side so we can euthanize it according to Animals protect act 71 of 1962 section 5.

The bull was really wild we then tried luring it towards the side with grass in order to use the captive bolt.We struggled a few minutes and two men who was with the guy transporting the bull then arrived.

We then tried putting a rope around the bulls neck with a lot of failed attempts we eventually succeeded and they restrained the bull in order for Elani to captive bolt it and then cut the neck.

Transportation warning 01 was issued to:

1.A bull was transported with a broken leg with no partitioning making him fall around .Therefore section 5 was utilized.Ensure to never transport injured animals in future.
